Application Procedure for Schools

1. Introduction

World Genius Search Examination –WGSE is introduced on a global platform after 12 years of brainstorming and analysis for right and precise assessment and caliber measurement. WGSE is currently open to Grade / Class 1 to 12. It will get extended to post graduate level from 2019 – 20.

1.1. Global Genius Awards 2018

WGSE is the Global Benchmark Test used for caliber measurement and to locate genius across the globe. It explores the ability of a student to apply Mathematics and Science for right decision-making. All the **100 percentile scorers** of WGSE 2018 from each Grade / Class are conferred with **Global Genius Awards 2018**.

1.2. The Scores: GPS and GII – Global Intellectual Index

The WGSE leads to prestigious **Global Genius Awards™** with two Global Scores:

Global Percentile Score™ (GPS)

GPS is the Grade / Class wise Global Percentile Score is offered on the global platform. All the WGSE participants with 100 percentile scores are conferred with Global Genius Awards 2018.

Global Intellectual Index™ (GII)

Global Intellectual Index is the most sought after caliber measurement score with detailed analysis. GII is offered on a scale of 0 to 9 and is drawn from the Global Percentile Scores of all the WGSE participated years, without any break. Consistent WGSE participation ensures more reliable and precise GII.

To get more clarity on GII, Consider this example. When a student participates in WGSE from Grade / Class 1 and appears for WGSE at the final year Graduation, the GII Score can be 15 Y – 8.12345. Here, 15 Y indicates the number of participating years without any break and 8.12345 indicates the precise caliber score drawn from the Global Percentile Scores of all those 15 years. Now, in India, the GII is connected to the National Identification Number or Aadhaar Number as per the Govt. directives and guidelines.

1.3. GII: Scope & Applications

As GII is a derived score from many years, it can be effectively used for a wide range of applications including campus recruitments, proficiency assessment, educational **loans**, admissions to various Universities, International Recognition & Scholarships. It acts as the Credible Caliber Index in Academics and Career. WGSE will be introduced for Graduate and Post Graduate Courses from next year. Thereafter the GII

with longer period (Class 1 to Graduation) will be more reliable get higher credibility and appreciation. GII can be termed as the Aadhaar in education.

GII Report can also be used for caliber and emotional assessment from various corners. As it identifies the weakness and limitations, students can get into remedial measures and overcome it easily.

1.4. ACFIO Recognition & Higher Credibility

WGSE is the first and the only Genius Search Examination / Olympiad accredited by Accreditation Council for International Olympiads (ACFIO). No other Scholarship examinations or Olympiads are accredited by ACFIO for quality and credibility.

1.5. WGC Safety Insurance & WGC Student ID

All the WGSE registered Indian students studying in India will get **WGC GROUP SAFETY INSURANCE** cover for ₹ 2 lakhs from The New India Assurance Company Limited, Govt. of India. In case of an accident, ₹ 80,000 on hospitalization expenses and ₹ 1 lakh on permanent disability are also covered. This cover will be extended to ₹ 5 lakhs for WGC PRIME Card holders.

As per the Govt. of India. directives and guidelines, WGC STUDENT IDs are the National Identification Number depends on their citizenship. In India the 12 digit Aadhaar number is the WGC STUDENT ID. The WGC IDs will remain the same for the life term.

Students from countries other than India, can use their National Identification Number. Those who yet to have their own National Identification Number (NID) or Aadhaar, can get a temporary ID from us and it will be replaced by the NID or Aadhaar Number as they get it.

Students having WGC IDs allotted during previous years are advised to intimate their Aadhaar Number to us for replacing it.

2.2. STEP – II : Collect the Registration Fee from students:

Note: * indicates that the school has to print the question papers send by us through email as password protected pdf files. If the school requires printed question booklets to be couriered to them, they need to remit Rs. 600 per student.

Schools are recommended to take the administrative expenses from students depends on the mode of question papers they opt from us.

** Schools situated in the countries other than India can get password protected Question Booklets in pdf format only

2.3. STEP –III: Remit the Fee

Complete the School Participation List (in the excel format) and Consent Form (SPL) with students' details. It can be downloaded from the Download Center of the website. Out of the fee collected, the school should retain the test administration expenses for the school as mentioned in the above table. Remit the balance fee to the account of the WGSE administrator – **World Genius Conclave Private Limited.**

The fee can be paid to the WGSE administrator's account in the following ways:

1. Deposit cash in the account of WGSE administering agency at any of the State Bank of India branches across India. Account details are given below.
2. Use NEFT / RTGS / SWIFT/ Net banking to transfer the fee to the WGSE administering agency
